Your Voice Matters!


U-Report is a free SMS-based platform that allows Ugandans to report on issues affecting them and their communities as well as to get real-time information and feedback on new initiatives or campaigns.

- ♦ U-report offers young Ugandans and the public at large a chance to voice their opinions on pertinent issues like health, education, water, sanitation and hygiene, youth unemployment, HIV/AIDS, disease outbreaks like Ebola and COVID-19 and natural disasters like drought, floods and landslides .
- Allows citizens to speak-out on what is happening in their communities, provides a forum to amplify their voices through local and national media, sends alerts to key stakeholders about the issues their constituents are facing, and feeds back useful information to the U-Reporters, so they are empowered to work for change and improvements




How it works






Background:




QN 1: "We would like to hear from you on the journey so far, please tell us, has U-Report benefited you in any way? Yes or No"




1. COVID-19 Vaccination: Messages for the General Public



QN: Now we would like to hear from you, tell us what you think or what people in your community are saying about the COVID-19 vaccine?







2. Intergarted Child Health Days (ICHDs) Campaign April 2021





QN 2: How did u hear about it? A) Radio B) VHT or Health worker C) Social media D) U-Report E) Community leader










Breakdown by Agegroups


QN 1: Please tell us, Do you know what Female Genital Mutilation (FGM) is? Reply YES or NO




 $849\,$ Responses . The majority $81\%\,$ answered affirmatively .

Age groups: The adults 35+, the majority 91% were knowledgeable as compared to the younger population btn 15 to 24 years old








Apart from your current water sources, are there any other alternative sources of water nearby in your community?





Do you think there is equal access for all people to the existing facilities in your community?







U-Partners Engagement

- 4,575 were treated as serious cases that needed follow up




Total nTotal number Replies provided




Messages recieved in the last Four months



Message labels in last 30 days




Total number of messages treated as serious and were handled as open cases




Top Two active partners on thye U-Partners Dashboard
